THE BAKERS TEA ROOM

7 SATURDAY MARKET PLACE, KING'S LYNN PE30 5DQ

A warm welcome to The Bakers Tea Room, opened August 2019 by long-time friends Keith Harrington and Paul Brandon, along with their wives Suzy Harrington and Teresa Brandon.

The business works in partnership with long established traditional bakers/confectioners Smiths the Bakers, located next door at 1 High Street. Who have been Royal Warrant Holders for over 30 years.

The Bakers Tea Room is located on King's Lynn's historic Saturday Market Place opposite the majestic building known as The Minster. The Minster was formally known as The Priory and Parish Church of St Margaret. Then in December 2011, The Bishop of Norwich dedicated the church as The Minster. Founded by the first Bishop of Norwich, Herbert de Losinga in 1101. The Minster has offered a welcome to pilgrims and visitors for over 900 years. You are welcome to join any service or just walk around enjoying the atmosphere of this historic and holy church.

Records suggest that there was a market taking place on Saturday Market Place long before proper records were kept. The oldest recorded instance of a market is to a "Sand Market" held on the Saturday Market Place in 1104.

The first "Charter Market" is mentioned in a charter from King John dated 6 September 1205. This charter permitted the people of Lynn to tax services and keep the revenue for themselves rather than paying it to the king. This included raising taxes from the setting up a stall at fairs/markets. It is understood that the Saturday Market Place would have been the obvious choice at this time.

During the reign of Henry third a group of men from Lynn joined rebellious Barons against King Henry. With Henry being victorious in a battle at Littleport, by way of punishment, King Henry took away the Charter rights granted by King John. Only to give the Charter back to the town in 1268 and in addition gave the town the permission to elect its own mayor.

In 1435 a licence was granted to the town to use the piece of land next to St Margaret's Church for a market. The licence runs for 999 years! It not clear whether this licence was merely a means to formalise an existing situation.

Until recent times butchers' have played a major role in the market area. In the 15th century the street opposite to the church was known as Butchers' Row due to the concentration of butchers' shops and until the 19th century the market place featured a building against the north side of the church known as the butchers' shambles. The first floor accommodated the grammar school. Stone plaques from this historic building can be viewed in the Stone Hall at the Town Hall.

King's Lynn's Town Hall (opposite The Minster) has a fascinating history having been built around 1421-23 following a fire that decimate the original Guildhall that stood on this site. Along with other historic buildings surrounding the Saturday Market Place we are proud to be located here, amongst such a wealth of history playing such a major role in the building of the town over the centuries.

Sadly, due to the demise of markets over time, there is no longer a regular Saturday market held here. Although there are farmer markets and other events held on a frequent basis.

In 2014 work was completed in giving the historic Saturday Market Place a major face lift. With changes including widening of footways and area for seated events. Costing £650,000 this was funded by the National Heritage Lottery Fund, Norfolk County Council and Borough Council.
